Conversation Starter

Which subject in school was most challenging for you?

Opening in Prayer

Pause for a few minutes to quiet your heart and mind. Ask God to help you hear His voice during this week's study and reflection.

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read [Revelation 3:7-13](#).

1. In vs. 7-8, we learn that Jesus *has the key of David* and has *opened a door for you that no one can close*. What do these statements mean? What does Jesus want you to know? See also: [Isaiah 43:10-13](#).
2. What are the good things Jesus sees when He looks at this church?
3. Jesus makes a promise to this faithful church in vs. 10. What testing is He referring to? When it comes to following Jesus, what testing (or opposition) do you face?
4. Jesus tells this church, and us, to *hold on to what you have*. What exactly are we to hold on to and how do we do this?
5. How do most people measure success in a church? Based on this passage, how do you think Jesus measures success?
6. What rewards are promised for those who listen and obey?

Soul Training

During this series through March 8, we're seeking to hear God's voice using the pattern in the letters to the churches in [Revelation 2-3](#). Visit brookwoodchurch.org/hearingGod to view an outline of the letter we're seeking to receive from God, plus other resources to help you hear from God.

Spend a few minutes in silence, preparing your heart to hear from God.

During weeks one and two, we asked God for a personal *greeting* and words of *affirmation*. In weeks three and four, we asked God to reveal specific *concerns* and His *challenge* for us. Last week we considered the negative *consequences* that result in not listening to God. This week, we'll consider the great *rewards* that are in store for us as we listen and obey.

Begin a sentence with,

If you follow My instruction, and make these changes, then _____.

Ask God to tell you what will happen, and what blessings and benefits will occur if you follow Him with all your heart.
