Please check on your child in his or her classroom if you see the last four digits of your phone number appear on the digital displays located in the Concourse and Auditorium. The Nursing Mothers' Room, located at the North Tunnel, is available if you would like privacy to nurse your child and still view the service. The Pod A Parents' Lounge and Pod I are also available if you would like to watch the service with your children.

What if I miss the offering?

What should I do if I want someone to pray with me, need encouragement, or wish to make a spiritual decision?
